

Music at Redeemer is a performance-based program. Students in the primary grades participate in a wide variety of activities including singing, movement activities, and rhythm instruments, moving toward a goal of independent music-reading ability. Middlegrade students continue with these activities, adding more formal training in musical note-reading and theory.

Third and fourth graders participate through their curriculum and vocal training while learning about the musical instruments. Students in fifth and sixth grades study the human voice and are introduced to part-singing. Seventh and eighth graders have a more intense study of theory and worship. All grades use their gifts in presenting special music for our Wednesday morning chapel services as well as Sunday worship.

In addition to the school program, children have the opportunity to participate in one-onone instruction in a choice of musical instruments:
